BP Marine launches Electro Technical Officers course

B.P. Marine Academy and Dohle Danautic India Pvt Ltd, jointly launched their first batch of Electro technical officers' course in BPMA campus, on January 14, 2008.

Mr. Stuart Allen, director chartering of Peter Dohle group, was the chief guest on the occasion. Among the prominent dignitaries who graced the launching ceremony were Capt Daniel Chopra, managing director, Dohle Danautic India PVT Ltd with his team comprising of Mr. Girish J Patil (technical superintendent), Capt Shashi Dsouza (director), Capt Rishi Sharma (Delhi office) and Mr Hazari (ex-director of S.C.I).

The guests were, initially, given a conducted tour of the sprawling B.P. Marine Academy campus which is endowed with the scenic view of 1,500 metres of waterfront. The campus is cradled in the beauty of Mother Nature. This was followed by the visit to Belapur campus for the guard of honour and lighting of the lamp and the cultural programme by the cadets and the ratings.

He said, "I am pleased to say that my company has selected 20 cadets from the first batch, and 26 cadets from the second batch in HND nautical science. We have also selected 15 cadets from HND marine engineering all, in
